A. Calls

a. The Rev. Dr. Deborah DeWinter: Renewal of Contract for Extended Service / First, Poughkeepsie

Pastor DeWinter is a UCC pastor serving First, Poughkeepsie under an Invitation to Extended Service which requires annual renewal by the SC.

b. The Rev. Michael Thomas: Termination of Call effective 29 February 2016

Pastor Thomas was issued a call through the Synod Council to serve New Hope Lutheran Church, Bronx in May 2002. Pr. Thomas was a coverage pastor for All Saints and St. Peter's, 140th Street, as well. New Hope for All Saints has been a partnership congregation of the synod / ELCA for several years. The recent full ministry review / consultation by ELCA staff and Pr.
