A. Grace, Uniondale: Holy Closure / Synod Preservation (\$13.24)

The congregation leadership had been working with the Bishop and staff for several months in discerning the congregation's viability as they were evaluating their declining membership, current financial status, and deferred property maintenance. The congregation council discerned they were no longer viable and recommended holy closure to the congregation, which was unanimously approved by the congregation on July 21.

The service of Holy Closure took place on Sep 1. Many of the congregation members are now worshiping at Epiphany – Epifania, Hempstead. With the congregation's closure, our synod will manage and take charge and control of the property and any of the remaining assets of the former congregation.
